The Arlington Council of PTAs awards three (3) teacher scholarships annually in the amount of \$300.00 All recipients will be notified by **April 29, 2021**. Recognition will be at the Arlington Council of PTAs May meeting.

- 1.** The Arlington Council of PTAs offers scholarships to teachers, teachers' aides, or other faculty members in AISD planning to take college credit courses, workshops or other continuing education which improves the applicant's teaching proficiency or applies to a specific education-related certification. These courses may include online and correspondence courses. Classes must be a minimum of 6 hours of study in a college or university.
- 2.** All applicants must have **at least 2 years** teaching or work experience in the AISD immediately **prior** to their application and will remain in the AISD the following school year.
- 3.** An applicant must be teaching or working in a school with a local PTA unit whose membership is in good standing with the Arlington Council of PTAs and Texas PTA. **If the local campus does not have an active PTA the teacher may join any other active PTA in AISD and submit the application through that Local PTA unit following the same guidelines.**
- 4. No late applications or information will be accepted. All deadlines must be met.**
- 5.** The application must meet the following eligibility criteria:
 - a) Completed application must be **received at the address listed above by March 26, 2021**
 - b) Application shall be **signed by the PTA President** verifying your PTA membership is in good standing;
 - c) **Letter of Recommendation** attached from an AISD administrator or school board member;
 - d) **Personal Profile Letter** attached briefly stating any comments about yourself that would help the scholarship committee know you as an individual. These comments may include a brief summary of goals, purpose of study, and why you feel you are a good candidate for this scholarship. Please use a separate piece of paper and limit your comments to one page; and
 - e) **Submit receipts for registration and/or books** from the college or university attending.
